

YSIBA Code of Conduct

Coaches and players will conduct themselves in sportsmanlike manner on or around the playfield. Respect will be given at all times to coaches, players and spectators of opposing teams, coaches players and spectators of their own team, game officials including umpires, scorekeepers and executive members of all associations.

The use of alcoholic beverages or being under the influence of such, the use of tobacco products and the use of profanity on or around the playing field area by coaches and players will be not be tolerated and the player or coach will be ejected from that game and be reviewed by the discipline committee.

Spectators will be the responsibility of the coaches of that team and must act in an orderly fashion while around the playing area. If a spectator(s) is warned by a coach and fails to adhere to league policy, he/she will be asked to leave and if they refuse the coach will ask the umpires to eject the said spectator(s) from the field area. A review will then be conducted by the discipline committee.
