



Code of Conduct - Players

- I will play to enjoy the game and improve my skills.
- I will strive to play to the best of my ability at all times, both at practice and during games.
- I will treat everyone fairly and with respect, regardless of gender, place of origin, colour, religion, economic status or disability.
- I will set a positive example. If I want to be treated in a certain manner, then I will treat others in the same manner.
- I will be encouraging and fair and show respect to everyone as they too have feelings.
- I will refrain from the use of profanity, insults and harassing or otherwise offensive language
- I will never argue with an umpire, opposing player or official. If I have a problem I will discuss it amicably.
- I will show mutual respect, tolerance, understanding, and caring in all team matters.
- Verbal or physical abuse of an official, coach, umpire, player or spectator will not be tolerated.

Code of Conduct - Parents

- I will remember that my child participates in sport for their enjoyment, not mine.
- I will focus on the child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing.
- I will encourage children to always play according to the rules and to settle disagreements without resorting to hostility or violence
- I will never ridicule or yell at a player for making a mistake during a game. I will give positive comments that will motivate and encourage continued effort.
- I will remember that children learn best by example. Appreciating good performances and skilful plays made by all participants
- I shall remember all Managers, Coaches, Officials, Officers and Auxiliary members are volunteers
- I shall notify the coaching staff of any absences or potential late arrivals as soon as possible to allow them to make any necessary changes to the roster.
- I will respect coaches decisions (...whether we understand, like, or agree with them!)...and, I will not "coach" from the stands.
